ORDINANCE 2004-01

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF CATAWISSA TO ENACT CERTAIN PENALITES AND RESTRICTIONS WITH REGARD TO SNOW REMOVAL.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Borough of Catawissa deems it to be in the best interest of the health, maintenance and welfare of the residents of the Borough of Catawissa to enact certain penalties and restrictions with regard to snow removal.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of Catawissa, Columbia County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

- 1. It shall be deemed unlawful for any person to remove snow from his or her property and to place that snow on a public sidewalk, roadway, or intersection.
- 2. It shall be deemed unlawful for any person to remove snow from his or her property and to place that snow in a manner that it obstructs any fire hydrant.
- 3. It shall be deemed unlawful for any person to remove snow from his or her property and to place that snow on the property of another.

PENALTIES

- 1. Any person violating the provisions as noted above shall be fined the amount of Fifteen and 00/100 (\$15.00) Dollars for any single offense during any twelve (12) month period.
- 2. Any person violating the provisions as noted above shall be fined the amount of Twenty Five and 00/100 (\$25.00) Dollars for any second offense in any twelve (12) month period.
- 3. Any person violating the provisions as noted above shall be fined the amount of Fifty and 00/100 (\$50.00) Dollars for any third or subsequent offense in any twelve (12) month period.
