ORDINANCE 2010- 204

AN ORDINACE AUTHORIZING COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF CATAWISSA TO MAKE CHANGES TO THE PARKING ORDINANCE, CHAPTER 15 OF THE CATAWISSA BOROUGH CODE.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Borough of Catawissa deems it to be in the best interest of the health, maintenance and welfare of the residents of the Borough of Catawissa to enact certain changes to Chapter 15 of the Catawissa Borough Code.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of Catawissa, Columbia County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

CHAPTER 15, SECTION 309. of Chapter 15 and shall read as follows:

This ordinance shall make changes to Section 309

Section 309. Penalties. Any person violating any provision of this part, excepting and reserving Section 308 shall, upon conviction thereof, be guilty of a summary offense and be subject to a fine up to Twenty five (\$25.00) Dollars, plus costs of prosecution. Provided, however, that whenever a police officer observes a violation of any provision of this part, such police officer shall attach to the vehicle parked in violation hereof a notice which shall contain instructions to the owner or operator of such vehicle advising him that if he shall pay, for the use of Borough, the sum of Fifteen (\$15.00) Dollars, by mail or in person at the Borough Hall, within 72 hours after the time of such notice, the same shall save such violator from prosecution and from payment of the fine in cost herein above. (Ordinance 268, June 9, 1983; as amended by Ordinance 277, December 10, 1984; as added by Ordinance 1997-2, November 10, 1997, Section 10).

And all other respects not inconsistent herewith, Chapter 15 of the Catawissa Borough Code shall remain unchanged.
