Council President Sue Helwig read the projected income, expenses and ending balance of the 2023 General Fund Budget. No questions were asked. Ms. Helwig read the projected income, expenses and ending balance of the 2023 Electric Budget. Councilman Kevin Ferris asked about the amount budgeted for professional services since the Borough subcontracted out to Hayden for electric emergencies. Councilman Jeff Fleming asked where in the budget is Tyler's wages. Councilman Steinruck stated part of it is in the budget for Hayden. Ms. Helwig read the projected income, expenses and ending balance of the 2023 Sewer Budget. Councilman Ferris asked if that money can only be used for sewer items, correct? Ms. Helwig responded "yes". Ms. Helwig read the projected income, expenses and ending balance of the 2023 Senior Center Budget. This budget is in a deficit of \$3,894.00. Ms. Helwig said next year Council will have to look at generating more revenue. Councilman Fleming mentioned the cost of cleaning services being high. Council is going to ask the Area on Agency if they would approve having the Senior Center cleaned once a month. Manager of Administration Connie Cole suggested Council do away with Miller's Cleaning at the Borough Hall and she will clean the office once a week to help with the General Fund Budget. Councilman Kevin Ferris is going to look into the savings on cleaning the Senior Center and having the Police Station cleaned once a month. Ms. Helwig read the projected income, expenses and ending balance of the 2023 Community Center Budget. No questions were asked. Ms. Helwig read the projected income, expenses and ending balance of the 2023 Liquid Fuels. No questions were asked. Ms. Helwig read the projected income, expenses and ending balance of the 2023 Eyer Fund. Ms. Helwig explained the Borough will do the last installment to the cemetery repair. No questions were asked. Ms. Helwig read the projected income, expenses and ending balance of the 2023 Capital Fund. No questions asked.
